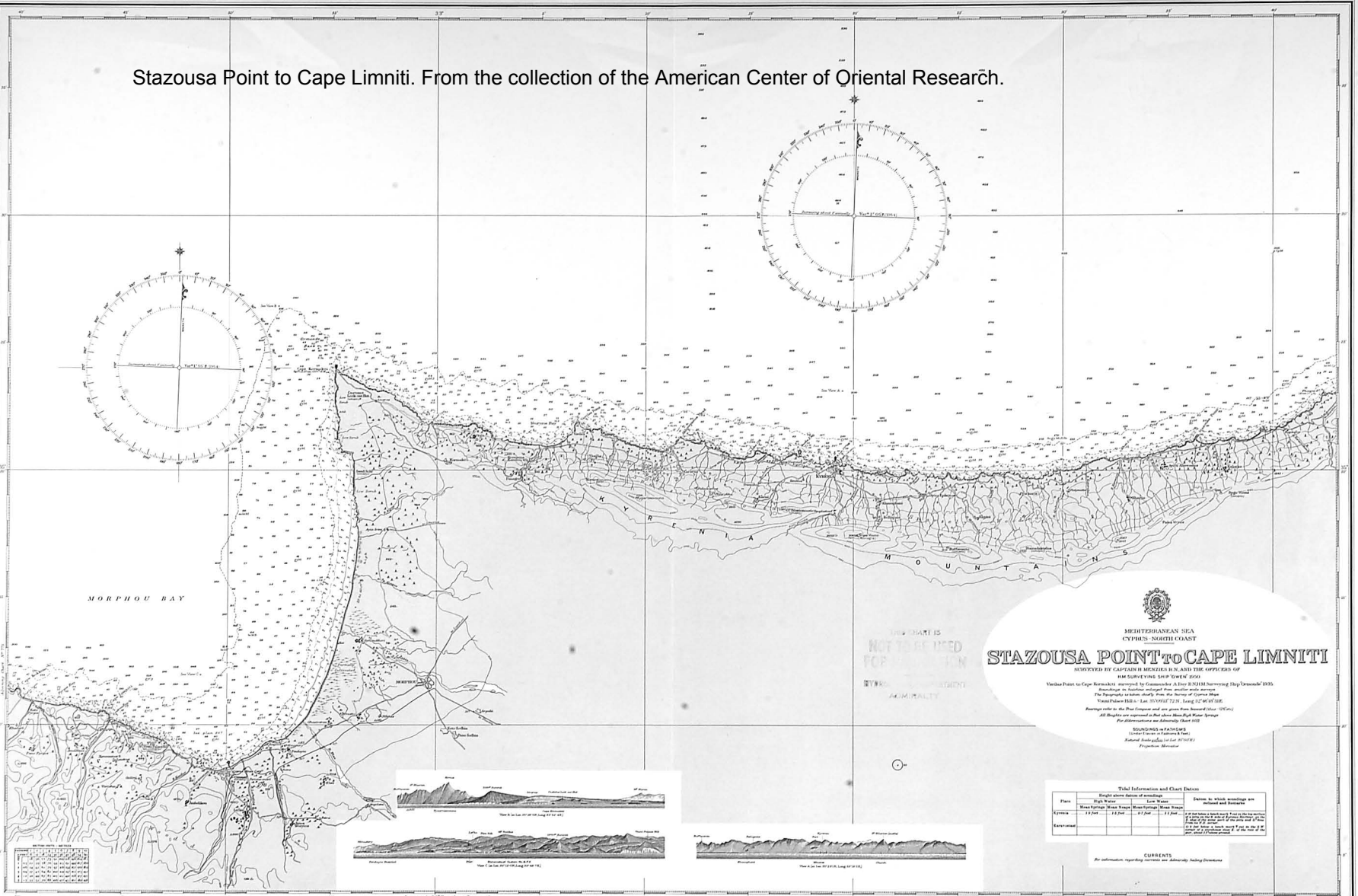


Stazousa Point to Cape Limniti. From the collection of the American Center of Oriental Research.
